Taking into consideration the amount of space required and whether the surface is appropriate?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Possible giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures The large indoor tennis centre is used as it provides a safe area for all activities to take place.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that adequate space has been provided for spectators?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered unsatisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Nil and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures Spectators are not allowed to watch. Staff will be either supporting their pupils or the young leaders.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that the movement of heavy equipment is restricted to individuals that have been appropriately trained?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures All heavy equipment i.e. badminton and volleyball posts, squash walls and table tennis tables are moved by TSSP or Blackbrook staff.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that there is adequate first aid provision, considering the number of participants in attendance and the types of activities taking place?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Possible giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures First Aid is available from the sports centre; schools are encouraged to bring their own first aid kits. Most TSSP are qualified First Aiders.</p>
<p>Hazard Is there a clearly defined first aid point on site?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Nil and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures First Aid point at sports hall reception.</p>

<p>Hazard Do you ensure that all unnecessary equipment is kept away from the field of play or areas in which activities are taking place?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures All unused equipment is moved outside the playing areas.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that any free standing equipment is securely anchored to the floor?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures All free standing equipment is appropriate to the activity. Most are anchored to floor by built on weights, i.e. badminton and volleyball posts. Squash wall are not fixed to floor.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that equipment is checked and is in good working order?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures Equipment checked before use. No equipment is used that is not in working order.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that equipment such as bicycles, rackets and bats are stored so as not to present a trip hazard to others?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Nil and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures Rackets and bats are stored outside of playing area.</p>
<p>Hazard Have participants been warned about the danger of colliding with others during activities?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Possible giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures Pupils are informed beforehand how to perform safely, however there is likely to be some minor collisions possibly in activities like volleyball and squash. Any pupil who consistently performs in an unsafe manner will be removed by the organisers.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that supervisors receive a briefing prior to the event/activity?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Nil and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures The 4 sports are being run by representatives from the National governing bodies who are all qualified. A TSSP sports coordinator will also be present to oversee the festival. Each activity will be run by young leaders who will be briefed on the skills & activities.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that participants are briefed about safety procedures in the event of an emergency, such as a fire alarm for example?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Nil and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures Pupils will be informed at the start of the activity.</p>

<p>Hazard Do you ensure that participants are briefed on the rules and practices of the activity, and that they are made aware of playing boundaries?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures The National governing body representatives and the young leaders will inform pupils about teaching points, rules and playing boundaries.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that participants wear footwear that is appropriate for the activity?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Possible giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures Schools are informed of what kit pupils should wear.</p>
<p>Hazard Do you ensure that all participants engage in an appropriate warm up before the activity commences and have a cool-down period afterwards?</p>	<p>Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Possible giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures</p>	<p>Notes/ Existing Control Measures The festival starts with a warm which will be led either by young leaders or the SSCo. Cool downs will occur where appropriate.</p>
