<b>Hazard</b> Do you ensure the pitch surface is non-slip	<b>Findings</b> The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The <b>severity</b> of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as <b>Moderate</b> and the <b>likelihood</b> of it occurring as <b>Possible</b> giving a <b>Risk Rating</b> that <b>doesn't require revised control measures</b>	<b>Notes/ Existing Control Measures</b> All pitches will be checked and hazards removed prior to play being allowed to commence. Judgements will be made following rain and the competition may be adapted or cancelled.
<b>Hazard</b> Is all equipment checked on a regular basis for defects?	<b>Findings</b> The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The <b>severity</b> of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as <b>Slight</b> and the <b>likelihood</b> of it occurring as <b>Unlikely</b> giving a <b>Risk Rating</b> that <b>doesn't require revised control measures</b>	<b>Notes/ Existing Control Measures</b> All equipment is checked by the staff in charge. The SASP/ school staff will check their safety each time the pitches are used
<b>Hazard</b> Are spectators / Players advised where to stand	<b>Findings</b> The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The <b>severity</b> of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as <b>Slight</b> and the <b>likelihood</b> of it occurring as <b>Unlikely</b> giving a <b>Risk Rating</b> that <b>doesn't require revised control measures</b>	<b>Notes/ Existing Control Measures</b> Staff and subs are allowed must stand off the pitch. Batters waiting to bat must also wait off the pitch. Spectators must watch from outside the pitch. Spectators watch at their own risk and are responsible for any siblings they bring with them. Players are warned to be aware of other cricket matches that are taking place.
<b>Hazard</b> What footwear and safety equipment is advised	<b>Findings</b> The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The <b>severity</b> of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as <b>Slight</b> and the <b>likelihood</b> of it occurring as <b>Unlikely</b> giving a <b>Risk Rating</b> that <b>doesn't require revised control measures</b>	<b>Notes/ Existing Control Measures</b> Players must wear trainers, Players do not have to wear helmets or gloves
<b>Hazard</b> Is First Aid provision provided	<b>Notes/ Existing Control Measures</b> Schools are directed to bring their own first aid kits and be responsible for their own pupils. SASP /School staff are first aid trained and will have basic first aid kits
