Most young leaders will have attended netball Young Officials training.
Hazard Do you ensure the court surface is firm, level and non-slip and outside courts are free from loose gravel?	Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Moderate and the likelihood of it occurring as Possible giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures	Notes/ Existing Control Measures All courts will be checked and hazards removed prior to play being allowed to commence
Hazard Do you ensure there is a minimum space of 1m (3ft. 3") between outside lines of the court and any obstruction e.g. netting, wall, kerb, and edging?	Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Moderate and the likelihood of it occurring as Possible giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures	Notes/ Existing Control Measures All courts confirm to All England specifications
Hazard Do you ensure all posts are stable and that, if free standing, are secured or weighted for stability and that bases do not project into the court?	Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Possible giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures	Notes/ Existing Control Measures All posts will be checked before play commences to ensure they are safe and do not come onto the courts
Hazard Is all equipment checked on a regular basis for defects?	Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures	Notes/ Existing Control Measures All equipment is checked by the staff in charge. The SASP/ school staff will check their safety each time the courts are used
Hazard Are spectators advised where to stand	Findings The Existing Control Measures are considered satisfactory The severity of any accident resulting from this hazard has been rated as Slight and the likelihood of it occurring as Unlikely giving a Risk Rating that doesn't require revised control measures	Notes/ Existing Control Measures Staff and players are allowed to stand inside the courts but not in the way of the umpires. Spectators must watch from outside of the fenced area. Spectators watch at their own risk and are responsible for any siblings they bring with them.
Hazard Is First Aid provision provided	Notes/ Existing Control Measures Schools are directed to bring their own first aid kits and be responsible for their own pupils. SASP /School staff are first aid trained and will have basic first aid kits
